Evaluation Criteria

The Section 5310 San Antonio Urbanized Area (UZA) Program Evaluation Committee shall evaluate the applicants based on both the technical application and the in-person presentation. The evaluation shall be based on the below weighted criteria.

Evaluation Committee Composition

VIA will chair the committee as a non-voting member. Members of the evaluation committee include:

- One VIA representative serves as chair (non-voting member)
- One representative from Alamo Area Metropolitan Planning Organization. The representative from AAMPO will facilitate proper coordination with the coordinated planning process
- Four representatives from community agencies knowledgeable of transportation needs for seniors and individuals with disabilities

<u>In-Person Presentation</u>

In addition to the technical application, applicants shall prepare and conduct a 15 minute in-person presentation that will be followed by a 10 minute question and answer time. Presentation shall include five components as follows:

- Project goals and objectives as related to the Section 5310 Program's aim to improve mobility by removing transportation barriers and expanding mobility options.
- 2. Project description
- 3. Explanation of how the proposed project provides public transportation for one or more of the following purposes:
 - Meet the special needs of seniors and individuals with disabilities when public transportation is unavailable, insufficient, or inappropriate (fulfills a gap)
 - b. Exceeds the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)
 - c. Improves access to fixed-route service and decrease reliance on complementary paratransit
 - d. Provides alternatives to public transportation projects that assist seniors and individuals with disabilities with transportation
- 4. Past experience and performance in executing the project, or ability to perform
- 5. Explanation of how the project is included in the locally developed, coordinated public transit-human services transportation plan

Timeline and Contacts

The application schedule below is dependent upon the annual allocation determined by the U.S. Congress. The annual allocation may be delayed beyond January or other conditions may require a revision to the schedule such as VIA Board of Trustee board meeting times.
