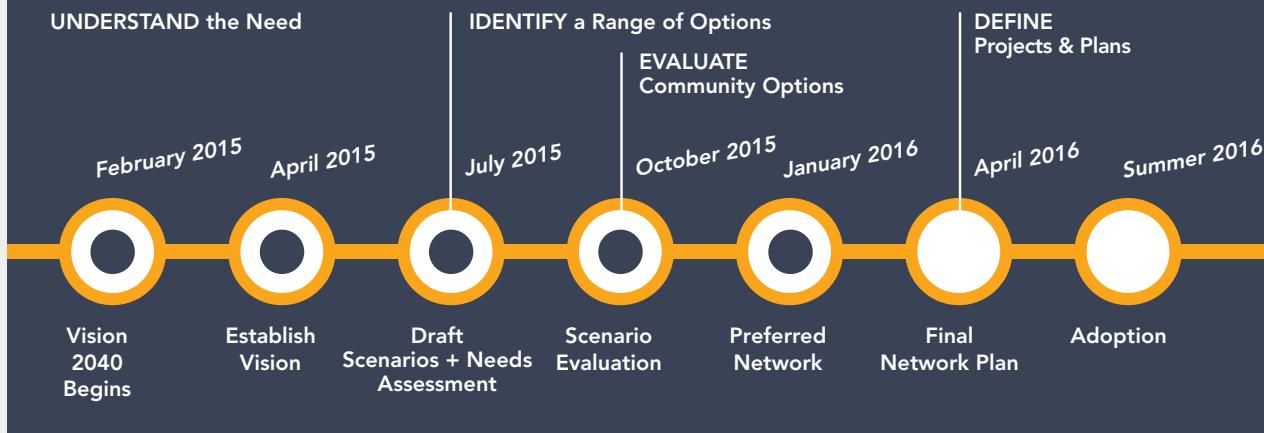

## Mapping out a Long Range Plan with more transit options

Throughout this planning process, which began in early 2015, we have heard residents want more travel options in their neighborhoods and throughout the region. Two vital surveys were conducted in the summer and fall of 2015. VIA received more than 7,000 survey responses and public comments. As a result, VIA's recommended Long Range Plan has three major elements, including:

1

### Enhancing the Bus System



- Offer 15-minute service throughout the system during peak hours.
- Design a network of priority Primo bus corridors.
- Improve shelters, sidewalks and crosswalks.

### Creating a Multimodal Network



- Build dedicated transit lanes for premium transit (light rail and bus rapid transit) connecting our region's busiest employment centers.
- Establish HOV lanes for express routes and vanpools.

### Embracing Innovative Solutions



- Invest in smart technology and transportation tools that expand available travel choices (i.e. mobile fare payment, ride-sharing, real-time information).
