Delta Air Lines' cancellation policy depends on the type of ticket you have purchased and the timing of your cancellation. All tickets, except for Basic Economy, can be canceled without a fee for most flights originating in the U.S., Canada, and the Caribbean. +1-844-833-2075 (US)

For all tickets

Basic Economy tickets

Basic Economy tickets have the most restrictions and are generally not changeable or refundable.

- Voluntary cancellation: You can cancel a Basic Economy ticket for an eCredit, but a cancellation fee ranging from \$99 to \$199 will be deducted from the ticket's value. If the fee exceeds the ticket value, you will not receive an eCredit.
- Award travel: Basic Economy tickets booked with miles can be canceled for a fee, and the remaining miles will be redeposited into your SkyMiles account.

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Canceled or delayed flights

If Delta cancels your flight or issues a significant delay or schedule change, you have the right to a full refund regardless of your ticket type.

- Significant delays: A significant delay is defined as a departure or arrival that is 3 hours or more earlier or later for domestic trips, or 6 hours or more for international trips. +1-844-833-2075 (US)
- Refund options: If your flight is significantly impacted, you can accept the rebooked flight, cancel for a refund to your original payment method, or receive an eCredit.

How to cancel your flight

To cancel your ticket, follow these steps:

1. Navigate to the "My Trips" section on delta.com.

3. Click "Need to Cancel?" and follow the prompts.

When Delta cancels a flight, it generally rebooks you on the next available flight at no extra cost. You can accept this new flight, request a different alternative, or cancel your trip for a full refund. Your options if Delta cancels your flight

Compensation and services for delays

eCredits for nonrefundable tickets

If you have a nonrefundable ticket (including Classic fares) and cancel outside of the 24-hour risk-free window, you will receive an eCredit for the ticket's remaining value, minus any applicable cancellation fees. +1-844-833-2075 (US)

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How to request a refund or eCredit

Delta Air Lines' baggage policy allows passengers one free carry-on bag and one personal item on all flights. Fees for checked baggage, along with specific size and weight limitations, vary depending on your destination, fare class, and any elite status you may have.

Carry-on baggage

- Carry-on bag: You can bring one carry-on bag at no extra charge. It must not exceed 22 x 14 x 9 inches (56 x 35 x 23 cm), including handles and wheels, to fit in the overhead bin. +1-844-833-2075 (US)

Every passenger, regardless of their ticket, is entitled to bring these items on board free of charge:

Free checked bags

In April 2025, Delta Air Lines implemented a new rule requiring passengers on domestic flights to check their bags at least 45 minutes before departure. This was a change from the previous policy, where the cutoff time could be as short as 30 minutes at certain airports. +1-844-833-2075 (US)

Deadlines for specific airports

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- Weight restrictions: There are generally no weight restrictions for carry-on bags on domestic flights, but international flights to certain destinations (including Beijing, Shanghai, and Singapore) have weight limits.
- Delta Connection flights: Due to smaller aircraft, larger carry-on bags may be gate-checked for free and returned upon deplaning. Only personal items are guaranteed to be carried on board. +1-844-833-2075 (US)

Checked baggage

Domestic U.S. flights

- Main Cabin and Basic Economy: The first checked bag is \$35 one-way, and the second is \$45.

Delta Air Lines demonstrates a relatively low cancellation rate compared to other major US airlines, consistently showing strong operational reliability. +1-844-833-2075 (US)

According to a NerdWallet analysis using U.S. Bureau of Transportation Statistics data, between July 2023 and June 2024, Delta tied with Southwest Airlines for the lowest cancellation rate among major carriers at 0.83%.

However, other sources present slightly different figures:

- 1.02% of flights canceled, according to a separate NerdWallet analysis focusing on on-time performance. +1-844-833-2075 (US)
- 1.0% between January and April 2025, according to Simple Flying, based on BTS data.
- 1.2% of flights, down from nearly 2%, according to the Wall Street Journal, as of January 2024. +1-844-833-2075 (US)

For a Delta cancellation to qualify for a refund, the reason generally must be a qualifying circumstance dictated by the airline or a federal regulation, such as a significant flight change by Delta, or the death of a passenger or immediate family member. The eligibility for a refund also depends on your ticket type, as nonrefundable fares are rarely eligible for cash refunds for personal reasons. +1-844-833-2075 (US)

Reasons for a full cash refund
