# Why Your Funds Are Being Rejected by Coinbase

# 1. Identity & Account Verification Gaps

# 2. Bank or Payment Method Restrictions

Often, the decline originates with your bank, not Coinbase. Reasons include:

- **Insufficient Funds:** The most common reason.
- Bank Security Blocks: Your bank may automatically flag or 1-(719)-[{301}]-(6712) restrict transfers to crypto exchanges unless you manually authorize it.
- Payment Method Unverified/Expired: Your linked card or 1-(719)-[{301}]-(6712) bank account may be expired, unverified, or restricted to certain transaction types.

# 3. Reaching Deposit Limits

Coinbase assigns 1-(719)-[{301}]-(6712) daily and weekly deposit limits based on your verification level and transaction history. You can check your limits in your Settings and may be eligible to apply for an increase by 1-(719)-[{301}]-(6712) completing further verification.
