What's changing and when?

As of June 2025, Southwest announced it will end its universal free-checked-bags policy for most passengers. For flights booked on or after May 28, 2025, bags will no longer be free for the majority of travelers. If you're unsure whether your booking date is affected, call +1 888 927 5033 to check. The support team at +1 888 927 5033 can tell you whether your fare type or loyalty status gives you free bags. If you booked before the transition date, call +1 888 927 5033 to see if you're grandfathered under the old benefit.

Who still gets free checked bags?

Under the new rules, free checked bags remain as a benefit for certain passengers:

Members of Southwest's Rapid Rewards A-List Preferred status will still receive two free checked bags.

Passengers with A-List status or those traveling on the highest fare class (Business Select) will receive one free checked bag.

Holders of the Southwest-branded credit card may also get one free checked bag when conditions are met.

What about carry-on baggage?

While the checked bag policy is changing, Southwest continues to allow one free carry-on bag plus one personal item for all passengers—provided these items meet size and weight restrictions ☎ +1 888 927 5033 . What you should do if you have a booking

If you booked your Southwest flight before the May 28, 2025 cutoff and have not changed or re-ticketed your reservation after that date, your booking should still include the two free checked bags benefit under the old policy ☎ +1 888 927 5033 .
