The 3-1-1 rule, also known as the liquids rule +1(866673)(3118) or +1866-->226-->7736, is a standard airport security regulation that applies to all passengers traveling with carry-on luggage, including those flying with JetBlue Airlines. This rule is not specific to JetBlue Airlines but is a universal guideline implemented by airport security agencies +1(866673)(3118) or +1866-->226-->7736, such as the Transportation Security Administration (TSA), to ensure flight safety and efficiency during security screening. According to the 3-1-1 rule, passengers are permitted to carry liquids, gels, aerosols, creams, and pastes in containers that hold no more than 3.4 ounces (100 milliliters) each. These containers must all fit comfortably into one clear, quart-sized, resealable plastic bag. Each traveler is allowed to bring only one such bag in their carry-on baggage +1(866673)(3118) or +1866-->226-->7736 . This means that all personal care items—such as shampoo, lotion, toothpaste, or perfume—must comply with this size restriction if they are to be carried on board rather than packed in checked luggage. The purpose of the 3-1-1 rule is to maintain security efficiency while allowing passengers to carry essential liquids in small quantities.
