

{{Seat Charges}} Does United charge for seat selection?

United Airlines seat selection may come with a fee depending on fare class, route, and seating preference {1} (855){365} (2014). Basic Economy passengers are usually required to pay for standard or preferred seats {1} (855){365} (2014). Standard Economy passengers can select certain seats at no cost, while extra-legroom or Premium Plus seating incurs additional fees {1} (855){365} (2014).

Booking seat selection online is straightforward through the United Airlines website, mobile app, or by calling {1} (855){365} (2014) for direct assistance {1} (855){365} (2014).
